Fast Food vs Motherhood...

This truth is very difficult for us to accept. We are trained to have a "right now" mindset: fast food, around-the-clock help-desks, overnight delivery, Internet shopping, 24-hour gas stations, etc, etc, etc. We have a mental and emotional habit of expecting results "right now." But Jesus taught us that the Kingdom of God, our transformation in Christ, is like a mustard seed, that takes time to grow, a farmer's field, that only slowly produces its crop, a hardworking merchant, who spends years and years searching for the pearl of great price.

How can we overcome our modern, right-now mentality to let God work in our lives at his own, wise pace? We look to our mothers for they are a school of wisdom. For nine months a mother bears her child, who grows slowly, but surely and steadily, in her womb. She knows that she cannot rush the process; she must be patient, both before and after the child's birth. And each day becomes a precious opportunity to love, to hope, to wait, and to trust in the mysterious plans of God. This is the experience of every mother, and most especially of the Mother of God, Mary. On this Mother's Day, we should thank our mothers for their many hidden sacrifices, their constant love, and their priceless generosity.
