

CANNOT MARRY IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH DUE TO A PRIOR MARRIAGE?

Pope Francis recently streamlined the process to petition for a declaration of nullity to make the process shorter. He also eliminated the mandatory fee. If a person is able to prove in this process that their prior marital bond was invalid for some reason, then he or she can marry in the Catholic Church or validate a current civil marriage. Please use the envelope for All Souls Day to list the names of your deceased loved ones who are not already in the book. Do this as soon as possible so that the names can be listed in our Book of the Dead which will be placed at the altar throughout the month of November.

Please bring pictures (approx. 4"x6") of your family members who have died, to place on the shelves at the altar, like last year. These will be displayed until November 29th. On that date we will celebrate Mass at St. Benedict at 7:00 a.m. and at St. John at 7:00 p.m. to close the Month of the Holy Souls.
