

St. Benedict Catholic Church Sunday, March 31, 2019 Fourth Sunday in Lent



Today is Laetare Sunday. The church assigns to "Laetare" – rejoice-Sunday in Lent – this beloved parable, the Prodigal Son, the story of great rejoicing. This father is the model of forgiveness during our own season of selfexamination. This parable, along with the ones about the lost coin and the lost sheep were all Jesus' response to the Pharisees who asked his disciples why he was eating with tax collectors and sinners. No more striking account of God's understanding and love for the sinner is to be found anywhere in the scriptures than in Luke's story of the forgiving father, who forgave his son that left and returned, and also his other son who complained and was bitter. Only good can come from forgiving.

First Reading: "Today I have removed the reproach of Egypt from you." Jos 5:9a, 10-12 Psalm: Taste and see the goodness of the Lord. Ps 34:2-3, 4-5, 6-7. Second Reading: So we are ambassadors for Christ... 2 Cor 5:17-21 Gospel: ... now we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found. Lk 15:1-3, 11-32

FIVE STEPS TO A GOOD CONFESSION

1. *Examine your conscience.* When we examine our conscience, we think about whether the choices we have made showed love for God, ourselves, and others. We ask ourselves whether we have sinned, either by doing something that we know is against God's law, or by not doing something that God's law calls us to do.

2. *Be sincerely sorry for your sins.* We express heartfelt sorrow. We tell God we are truly sorry for our sins and firmly intend not to sin again. We say the Act of Contrition.

3. *Confess your sins to a priest.* Simply tell your sins to the priest. He may ask you questions or give you advice.

4. **Resolve to amend your life.** True contrition for sins is more than an emotion of remorse for sin. True contrition means that we intend to live differently from now on.

5. *After your confession, do the penance the priest assigns.* Perform your penance as soon as possible. Spend some time with Our Lord thanking and praising Him for the gift of His mercy.

Merciful Lord, with a pure heart I thank you for taking away my sins and I renew my desire to be your faithful friend and servant, increase my loving dependence on you, and grant me that joy and peace of heart which comes from doing your holy will. Through Christ our Lord. Amen. FORMATION


