# **GENUFLECTING-WHEN AND WHY YOU SHOULD**

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) states: "A genuflection, made by bending the right knee to the ground, signifies adoration, and therefore it is reserved for the Most Blessed Sacrament, as well as for the Holy Cross only at the solemn adoration during the liturgical celebration on Good Friday. We genuflect before we enter our pew ,and upon exiting, out of adoration for the Blessed Sacrament. During any procession (this includes the procession to receive Communion) we do not need to genuflect. When receiving Holy Communion, the communicant bows his or her head before the Sacrament, as a gesture of reverence, and receives the Body of the Lord.
