#### **SCRIPTURE & STORY WITH FATHER**

## THE MEANING AND EFFECTS OF THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

In the Sacrament of Confirmation we receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit (CCC, 1287), specifically receiving an outpouring or increase of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit (CCC, 1303). By once again renewing our baptismal promises, confirmation completes the Sacrament of Baptism (CCC, 1285, 1304), and therefore more firmly unites us with Christ, the Church, and God as our Father (CCC, 1303). We receive a special strength and character to witness, spread, and defend the Gospel (1303-1305). During the Rite of Confirmation the above effects come through the words and actions of the Bishop, the anointing with Holy Chrism, the laying on of hands, and the words "Be sealed with the Holy Spirit."

Lord, I am not worthy

The Church gives us this Easter season to reflect on our new life in Christ. Sometimes our boats may be empty, but we can tap into his power and he will fill them. In the Mass, Jesus calls us to come and receive him. And like the apostles, we acknowledge our needs. When the moment the priest holds up the Body and Blood of Christ and says: "Behold the Lamb of God. Behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." And everyone responds: "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed." In other words, "Lord, without you my boat is empty. I'm not worthy to receive you, but please heal me and fill me with your loving mercy." Let's continue our journey with Christ in this Season of Easter to strive in living in his image and likeness. Worthy is the Lamb!
